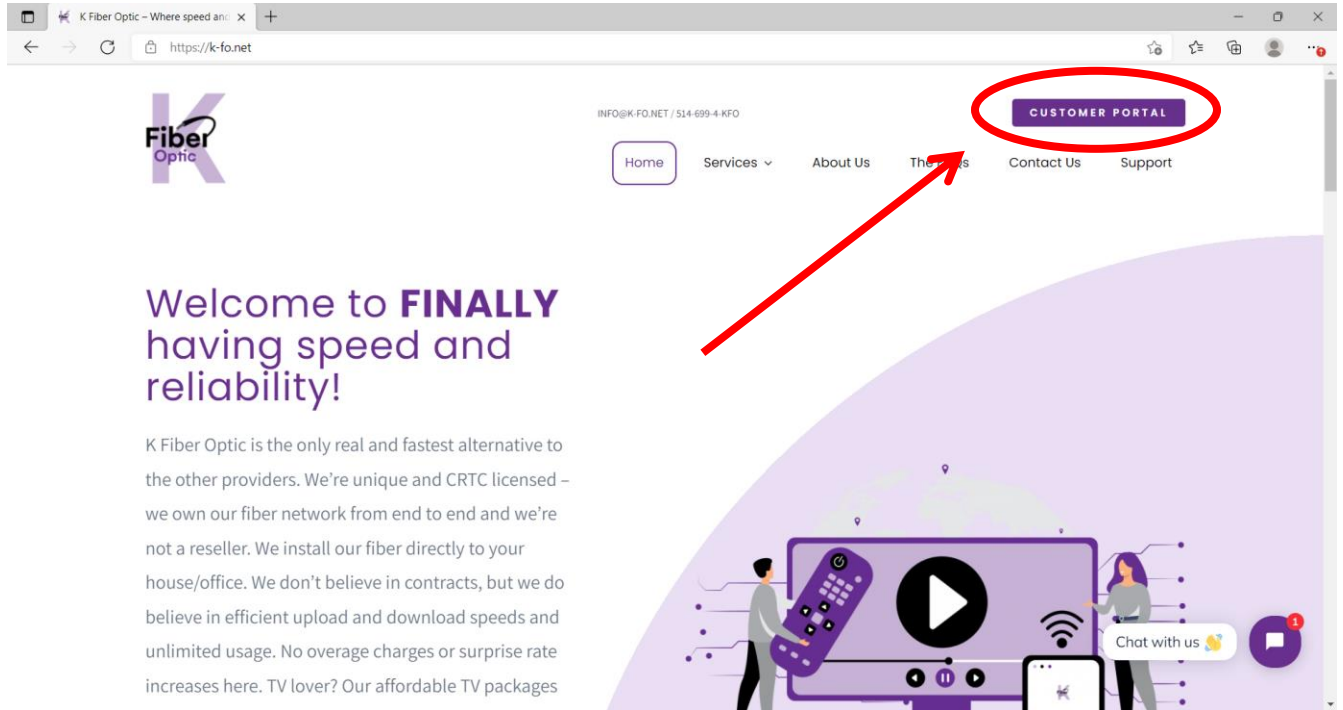
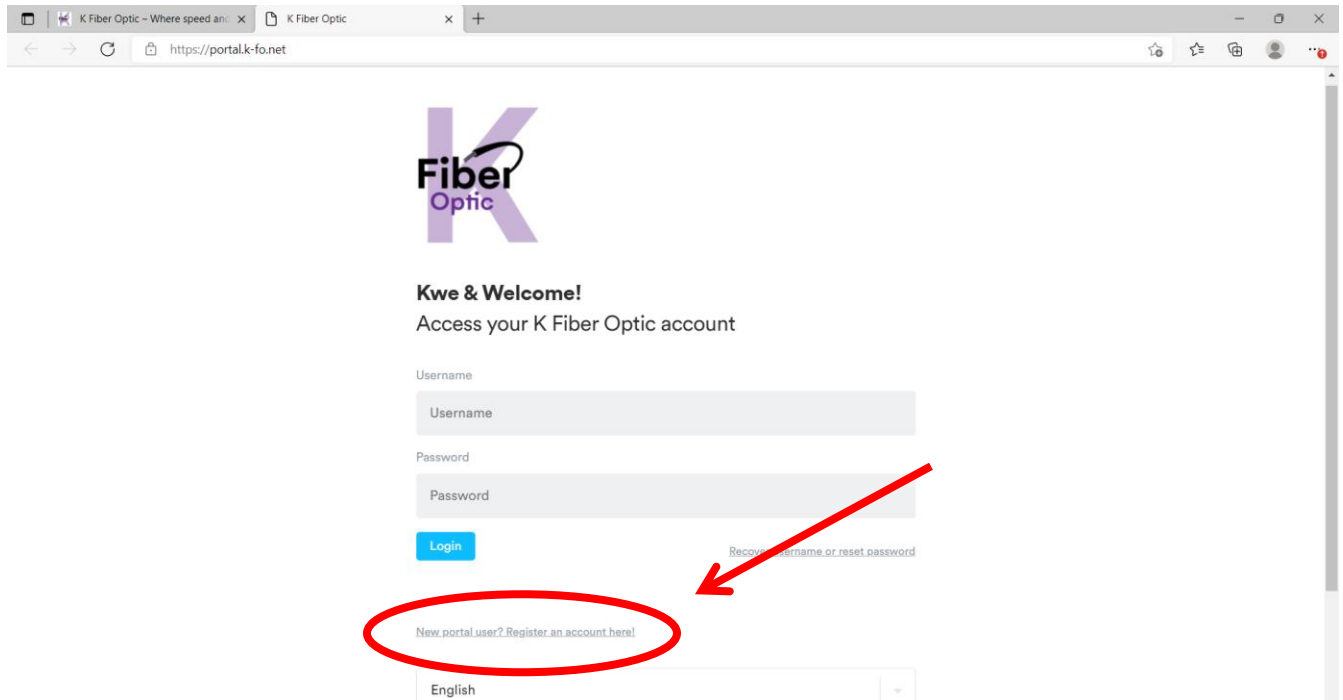

1. On the [k-fo.net](https://k-fo.net) home page, click on CUSTOMER PORTAL






